SCENE BREAKDOWN:

1. **“Can I Ask You Something?”** - Opening: What seems like a simple question can be loaded with so much more, one can never know.
2. **“Ding!”** - Rumors via Social Media: The impact that social media has when it comes to spreading rumors.
3. **“The Mirror”** - Body Image: Students look in the mirror and reveal what, they believe, is looking back.
4. **“Three Little Puffs”** - Vaping: Highlights the known, and even scarier, unknown risks of vaping.
5. **“Regrets”** - Drug Use: One bad decision costs a straight A student her college dreams.
6. **“Choose Your Own Adventure”** - Buzzed Driving: After an evening of drinking a teen is faced with a question “is buzzed driving drunk driving?”. (*Audience helps to choose this teens fate.*)
7. **“Release Realization”** - Self Injury: Many students feel like they must live up to lofty expectations and for some the responsibility can be overwhelming.
8. **“Stigma Machine”** - Accepting Neurodiversity: Our brains all work differently, isn't it time we accept all neurodiversity?
9. **“It's What You Do”** - Sexual/Verbal Pressure: Two girls talk about relationships and the difference between what their partner wants vs what they want.
10. **“Coming Out”** - Sexual Orientation: A gay student comes out to his best friend and brother.

11. **“No Means No”** - (Middle School) Acquaintance Rape: Exploring the concepts of consent, and rape.
11. **“Mariah and Sam”** (High School) Acquaintance Rape: Exploring the concepts of consent, and rape.
12. **“Love, Stop, Think”** - Talking About Sex: Taking a look at the way teens look at sex, and how to have an open conversation about the sensitive topic.
13. **“Can I Ask You Something” Reprise** - Ending: When someone asks you a question keep the line of communication open.
